

HUD EHL
(Emergency Homeowners' Loan Program)
Deadline is July 22, 2011

The program will assist homeowners who have experienced a reduction in income and are at risk of foreclosure due to involuntary unemployment, underemployment, due to economic conditions or a medical condition.

The Emergency Homeowners Loan Program (EHL) can provide eligible homeowners with a 0% interest, forgivable loan that pays past-due mortgage payments (principal, interest, taxes, insurance, attorney fees), as well as a portion of the homeowner's mortgage payment for up to 24 consecutive months, or up to \$50,000, whichever comes first, and provide that certain eligibility requirements are maintained.
